Overview

About Kaas Plateau Tour 2025 from Mumbai

Kaas Plateau is famously called Maharashtra Valley of Flowers. Kaas plateau in Satara is an eco-sensitive place you can see the carpet of flowers after the monsoon ends. During monsoon, Kas Pathar flower valley receives hefty rainfall; you can see different flowers throughout the year. Kaas Plateau has become famous for the various shades of the carpet and the tiny flowers that grow on the Kas Pathar Satara. UNESCO in June 2012 announced Kaas Plateau as a Biodiversity World Heritage Site.

One particular Satara Flower *Aponogeton Satarensis* or Waytura Flower can only be found on Kaas Maharashtra Plateau now listed in endangered species. Kaas Plateau supports 175 species of wildflowers. During our tour, we will see flowers that blossom after the monsoon. Kas Maharashtra Pathar is home to many birds, butterflies, reptiles, and wild animals.

The best time to visit Kaas Plateau season 2025 is just after the end of the monsoon during September and October. Once in eight years, Karvi Flowers blooms into mass flowering covering the entire Kaas Maharashtra Plateau in shades of Purple Blue and Pink. Kaas Plateau Booking 2025 register in advance as limited passes are available. Kas Pathar images are available in Photo gallery and a video explaining the tour.

Thoseghar Waterfall



Thoseghar Waterfalls get its name from the small village of Thoseghar located 20 km from Satara. We will pass Sajjangad Fort and windmills to reach the scenic Thoseghar Waterfalls. Satara is famous for many waterfalls like Vajrai Waterfall 2nd highest plunge waterfall in India, and Kelavali Waterfall. Chalkewadi is an amazing hamlet with many windmills dotting the landscape.

Thoseghar offers spectacular views with a series of waterfalls converging and one waterfall 200 meters in height. On a Rainy day, Thoseghar Waterfalls is covered in fog, and the nearby Chalkewadi Plateau famous for windmills electricity project is not visible. The best time to visit Thoseghar Waterfall is from July to November or on a Rainy day. Thoseghar is a very calm and relaxing place with rice fields and lush green forests with small streams.

Covid Safety Guidelines

- Before planning any adventure activity, please improve your minimum physical fitness. Most of us have been at home for a lockdown period.
- Please convey your real medical conditions to Treks and Trails India while enrolling for the event.
- Kindly wear three-layered masks, N95. Carry an extra disposable mask with you. Please ensure all participants, leaders, staff, and general persons wear masks before interacting with them.
- Carry with your hand wash, and a sanitizer bottle, and clean your hands before touching food and objects.
- Cover-up wears full sleeves shirts and full pants, hiking shoes, caps, and a face bandana over your mask. Covering up will help reduce exposure to the Covid19 virus.
- Bring your food and water with necessary cutlery like a utility mug, fork, and spoon. Your mug can be used for cooking, eating, and drinking water. Carry your reusable water bottles; please don't share them with others.
- Cooperate for temperature checks, questions reading any symptoms, and oxygen level checks; these are done to help you limit the spread of the virus. All these checks will be conducted multiple times during the activities.
- Kindly do not register for the event or travel if you have come in contact with someone who has Covid19 in the last 14 days.
- If you have any symptoms like fever, dry cough, weakness, body aches, etc., at the time of screening. You won't be able to participate in the event. You will have to be evacuated on the medical condition and should report to the nearest healthcare center.
- Maintain a distance of six feet or more while sleeping at night. In case the distance is not possible, try sleeping in a criss-cross manner to avoid face proximity.
- Please bring your garbage back to the city and dispose of it in your bin.

- If any participant, or trek leader test positive after returning from the event within 14 days of the Activity. They should maintain transparency and inform Treks and Trails India. It will help all others isolate themselves and get tested. Participants and Treks and Trails will cooperate to help manage the situation.
- Carry your own personal gear.
- Keep the conversation with unknown people to a minimum and maintain a distance of more than 6 feet while talking.
- Avoid speaking with the general population and maintain distance to keep yourself safe in these difficult times.
- Participants need to install the Arogya Setu app

Cancellation Policy

- 75% refund if notified via phone conversation 8 or more days prior to the event date.
- 50 % refund if notified via phone conversation 4 to 7 days prior to the event date.
- No refund if the cancellation requested is less than 3 days prior to the event date
- No show No Refund.
- Event Tickets cannot be transferred to another date against cancellation.

- We do not destroy or dirty the archaeological, historical monuments, or natural habitats on the trek.
- Swimming is not allowed in the lake or water tank on the forts. Locals use that water for drinking.
- Putting your feet in water tanks or on the canon is not allowed on our treks.



- Any addiction is strictly prohibited, e.g. drinking, smoking, chewing tobacco anyone caught doing it will have to exit the trek without a refund and travel back at own expense.
- People caught smoking or drinking alcohol will be asked to exit the event on an immediate basis.
- Please do not carry or wear any valuables, ornaments, jewelry, etc. If carried, then we Do Not take any liability for the same.
- Rock Climbing, Rappelling, Trekking, or any adventure activity is potentially risky. For all these events, you are at your own risk. Organizers are not responsible for any accident or compensation in whatsoever manner.
- We should strictly follow the code of conduct to avoid troubling our fellow trekkers or other people from our group or outside.
- Listening to music on earphones or Bluetooth speakers is not allowed while trekking.
- Bluetooth speakers are not allowed inside the homestay or camping tents.

Kaas Pathar Trek a beautiful walk and celebrate the festival of flowers in Maharashtra, with a fantastic variety of flowers and wildlife in Satara. The Kaas Plateau, also known as the Kaas Pathar, is a plateau situated 25 kilometers west from Satara city in Maharashtra, India. It falls under the Sahyadri Sub Cluster of the Western Ghats, and it became a part of a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site in 2012.

When should I go to Kaas Pathar Satara?

Kaas Pathar best time to visit is right after the monsoons, that is, in September and October, while the flowers at kaas pathar are in full bloom. Blooming is in full force starting from a week or two after the rain stops, if there is continuous sunshine, so keep on the lookout for the Kaas Plateau weather. Flowers at kaas pathar has more than 450 flower, orchid, and carnivorous plant species, including Drosera Indica. Passes sell out weeks in advance, so do your Kaas Pathar booking early.



Satara Kaas Plateau booking 2025 has started for September and October; please chat with us for details.

How do you get to Kaas Plateau Flower valley Pune?

You can take a train up to Satara railway station (Koyana Express from CSMT in Mumbai). After which you can take a bus from the Satara bus stand to Bamnoli. Direct buses to Satara are available on MSRTC websites. Private buses are available from Dadar Chembur, Vashi, Nerul in the evening.

The best time to visit Kaas Pathar flowers is from mid-September to mid-October once the season is over Kaas Pathar booking online is disabled. Pune to Kaas Pathar Satara distance is 136 kilometers it will take four hours to cover this distance. [Kaas Pathar from Pune](#) itinerary click on the url.

Which is the best season to visit Kaas Pathar?



Kaas Pathar best season to visit is in the monsoon months of July-August-Sept. The plateau looks beautiful during the season with lovely colours of Smithia flower and Karvi flowers. You can take your kids, and the place is right for senior citizens. Kaas Pathar season 2025 will last for a maximum of two months.

Sahyadri is home to many rainy season flowers in India. You can spot the Vaytura flower, Pandhara Sapkanda flower, Abhali flower, Orchid, Abolima flower, Sonki flower, Kavala flower and Halunda flower. The best time to visit Kaas Pathar Valley of flowers Maharashtra is September and October.

How do I get from Satara to Kaas Plateau?

It's around 25 kilometres from Satara to Kaas Pathar. To reach the Kaas plateau flowers, you can get a bus from the Satara bus stand. Ask for a bus going towards Bamnauli or Tetli; which leaves beginning from 6 AM. It will drop you at the Kaas Maharashtra Plateau at around 6:30 AM. There is one ST transport each hour.



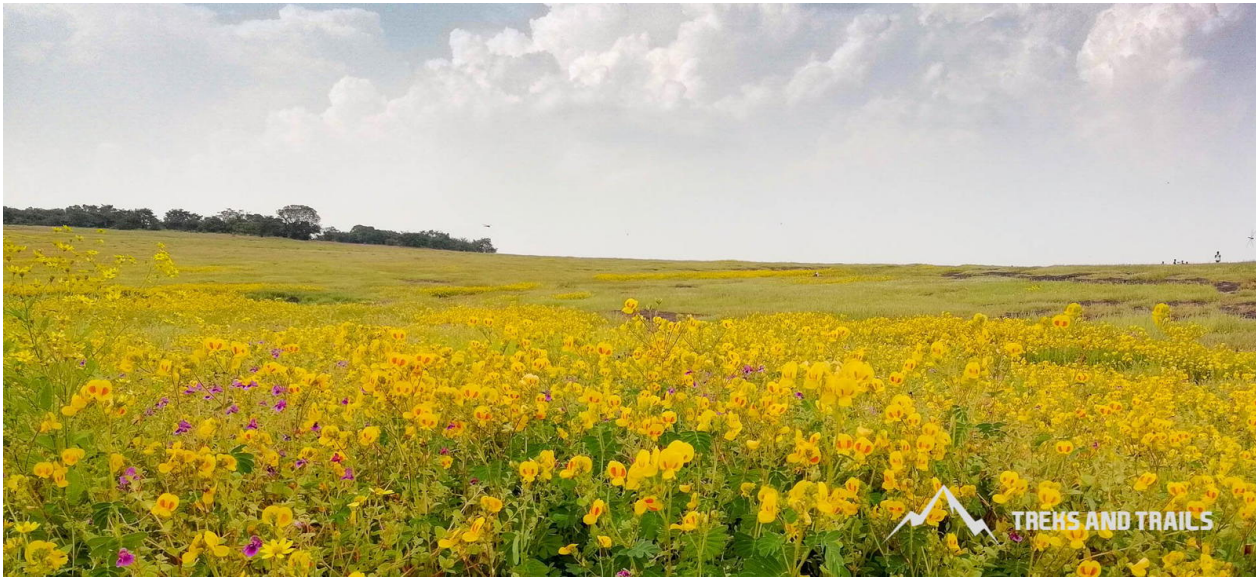
In 2012, Kaas Pathar was named by UNESCO as one of India's World Natural Heritage Sites.

Pune and Kaas plateau is 140 kilometers, or four hours of driving. The best time to visit Kaas Pathar is from September to October.

How do you get to Kaas Plateau from Mumbai?



Mahabaleshwar to Kaas Pathar Satara is located 45 km and around 30 km from Satara in Maharashtra. The distance between Pune and Kaas Plateau is 136 km, reached in 2.5 to 3.5 hours via NH4. Its distance from Mumbai is 278 km and takes around 5 hours to reach by road via the Mumbai-Pune Expressway and then NH4.

The more adventurous visitors can even enjoy a bracing Kaas Plateau trek in the area, taking in the views and savoring the escape from the hustle and bustle. The Kaas Plateau Maharashtra is also known as the Kas Maharashtra Pathar which situated in the Western Ghat Sahyadri range, 22 kilometers from Satara. Kaas Plateau best time to visit 2025 is from September to October.

Kas Talav Satara is located near Yekiv, Kaas Mahabaleshwar road. It is famous for the Kumudini Flower. Kas Pathar distance from Pune is 140 kilometers. You will need a forest permit to see the monsoon flowers in India.

Flowering at Kaas Plateau season is a natural phenomenon lot of factors determine good flowering year you can google #kaasplateau for updated images to check flowers. We plan the visiting dates so that our participants have maximum chances of seeing wildflowers. Kindly confirm your Kas Pathar booking in advance as the number of passes available and slot timings sells out quickly. It takes four hours to drive 140 kilometres from Pune to Kaas Plateau. The Kaas Pathar season for 2025 will only last for a maximum of two months.

2. Toilet Facility at Kaas Valley of Flowers [Satara](#)?

Kaas Plateau Satara does not have public toilets. Toilets will be available when we stop for breakfast and lunch at the restaurant. In 2019 portable public toilets were installed near the entrance of the Kas Maharashtra Pathar Satara but it changes every year.

Yes, it rains quite a lot at Valley of Flowers Satara Maharashtra do carry your umbrella, Poncho, Rain jacket. Umbrella will also come handy on a sunny day.

Pro tip: Always carry an umbrella on this tour and a hat. Weather changes here quickly. It can be foggy or rainy, followed by a sunny day.

7. Changing Facility at Satara Kaas Pathar?

There are no proper changing rooms available on this tour we will try to accommodate your request.

8. What can I see at Maharashtra Kaas Pathar other than flowers?

Kaas Pathar Satara has a beautiful climate during monsoon the Bamnoli lake below Kas Pathar flower season is perfect to sit and relax we will try to show you maximum flowers possible. You can see windmills at Chalkewadi. Sajjangad fort from distance. If you enjoy watching birds, butterflies you will enjoy the day. Kaas Pathar Satara booking needs to be done in advance as there are limited passes and they sell out weeks in advance.

9. Thoseghar Waterfall?



Thoseghar Waterfall is around two hours away from Kaas Plateau Satara we will visit this majestic waterfall. The forest department has developed a well-marked walking path and viewpoints for the many waterfalls in this region. There is a camera fee and entry fee applies to enter the waterfall. Thoseghar Waterfall entry tickets can be bought on the spot though for Kaas Pathar Satara online booking is compulsory.

10. Can you tell me about Chalkewadi Windmill Farms?



There are hundreds of towering Windmill setup for electricity generation. The windmill farms are located near Thoseghar waterfall one hour drive from Kas Maharashtra Pathar Satara.

11. Will we visit Sajjangad Fort?

We will pass by Sajjangad Fort on our way to Thoseghar due to time limitations we won't be able to visit. To completely explore many forts around Satara we would need 2 - 3 days.

During India's rainy season, Sahyadri is home to a variety of flowers. A variety of wildflowers that are observable, including the Vaytura flower, Pandhara Sapkanda flower, Abhali flower, Orchid, Abolima flower, Sonki flower, Kavala flower, and Halunda flower. Maharashtra's Valley of Flowers is at its most picturesque during September and October.

Ajinkyatara means The Impregnable Star is a fortress on one of the seven hills encircling the town of Satara in the Sahayadri Mountains of Maharashtra, India. The Ajinkyatara fort established at Ajinkyatara Mountain, which is 3,300 feet above the sea level. Ajinkyatara



Satara has been the place where various crucial moments in Maratha history took place. Ajinkyatara Killa Satara, presently it also operates the television tower for the town of Satara.

16. Balsam flower season in India?

You can see Balsam Flowers in the wild at the Kas Pathar Satara. The impressive characteristic of Valley of Flower Maharashtra is the pink Balsam flowers spread over the plateau. Balsam Flowers are popular gardening flowers planted during May and June; they usually flower in August and September.

17. Carnivorous plants at Kas Pathar?

Gawati Davbindu is a carnivorous plant at the Kaas Pathar Satara. It is also referred to as Drosera Indica, Flycatcher plant, or Indian Sundew. The topsoil at Kaas plateau Satara is very low in nutrients, so plants, the Gawati Davbindu, absorb nutrients from insects for their growth.

Davbindu meaning in English, is Dewdrop. The plant size is cm and difficult to spot. It will be best if you carry magnifying glass for this tour.

18. Distance between Satara to Pune?



Both cities are 110 kilometres apart. The road condition during the rainy season is bad; it will take three hours to cover this distance. We have Kaas Pathar Pune Tour with the Thoseghar waterfall trip available.

19. Kaas plateau to Pune distance?

Kaas Pathar distance from pune is 140 kilometers. It will take you four hours to cover this distance. Kaas Pathar Valley of Flowers Pune booking starts from 1 September.

20. Karvy flower details?

Usually, it takes seven years for the Karvy Flower or Strobilanthes Callosa shrub to reach maturity. It doesn't begin to blossom until the eighth year.



In a mass flowering that covers many forest areas with a colourful lavender blush of buds with a tinge of pink and its profusion of violet blooms at that time, the pink and white buds bear bright purple purplish blue flowers.

Following this once-in-a-lifetime mass flowering, the bush eventually dies out. A variety of butterflies, birds, and insects, including honey bees and carpenter bees, come to feed on the nectar of the blooms because they are rich in pollen and nectar.

21. Kas Talav Satara and the beautiful white flower of Kumudini Flower?



The Kas Talav is located one kilometer inside the Kas Plateau Reserved Forest. It is famous for the Kumudini flower plant or *Nymphoides Indicum*. The hike is amazing; you can see many beautiful flowers spread across the Kaas valley. Yellow Sonki flower, which looks like small sunflowers. Locals call this place as Kumudini Talav.



The easily different *Smithia* or popularly known as the Mickey Mouse flower, you can also spot Ground orchids, the rare *Ceropegia Vincaefolia*.

Satara Kaas Valley of flowers is like a Grassland of wildflowers. A Hidden gem near the busy city of Satara. It's a place where you can go to escape the hustle and bustle of everyday life and enjoy the beauty of nature.

22. Which is the state flower of Maharashtra?

It is a deciduous tree with blooms ranging from brilliant pink to pale purple. Often known as the enormous crepe-myrtle, queen's crepe-myrtle, banabá plant, or Pride of India.

23. Reverse waterfall in Satara?



Satara is famous for waterfalls; during the rainy season, we can see reverse waterfalls at the Thoseghar waterfall, Vajrai waterfall, Kelavali waterfall and Chalkewadi Pathar.

24. Mahabaleshwar to Kaas plateau distance?

Kaas Pathar Satara is located 40 kilometers away from Mahabaleshwar. It will take you two hours to cover the Mahabaleshwar to Kaas Plateau distance. You will need a permit to visit the Kas Plateau Reserved Forest, and please book in advance as there is a limit on the number of visitors.



25. Mumbai to Kaas plateau by train?

You can follow this guide to visit Satara Kaas Pathar by train.

1. Board any train that reaches Satara by 4 am
2. You can take a rickshaw or State transport bus to Satara Bus Depot.
3. Board the first available bus From Satara to Bamnoli
4. Get down at Kaas Plateau Satara and visit the check post
5. Buy your permit and walk to the Maharashtra Plateau.

26. Kaas Plateau Photo



The Kaas Pathar, also known as the Kas Plateau Reserved Forest, is a plateau found 28 kilometres west of Satara in Maharashtra, India. It was designated a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site in 2012.

Macro photography is like looking at the world around you through a magnifying glass. Everything appears larger and more detailed than it does to the naked eye.



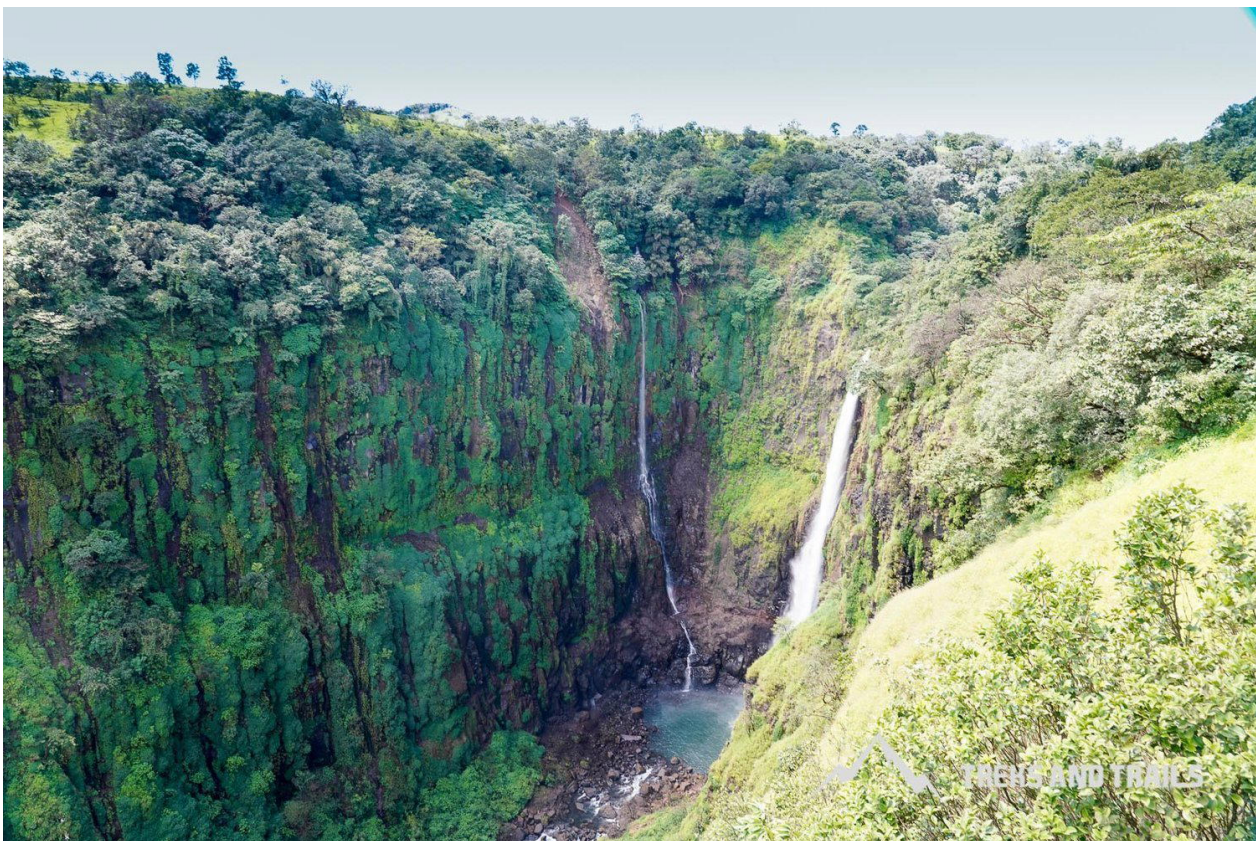
