Tirthan Valley Itinerary

Day 1: Depart from Delhi by 07:30 pm

Depart from Delhi at 07:30 PM in an AC vehicle, with a dinner stop at a roadside restaurant. The journey begins from Majnu Ka Tila, near Vidhan Sabha Metro Station.

Day 2: Jibhi sightseeing | Overnight stay at Jibhi

Starts with arrival in Aut, followed by a local transfer to the homestay in Jibhi. After breakfast and some relaxation, explore Jibhi Waterfall and Mini Thailand. Return to the homestay for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 3: Visit Jalori Pass | Trek to 360 viewpoint and Serolsar lake | overnight stay at Jibhi

After breakfast, head to Jalori Pass for breathtaking views of the Himalayas and Kullu Valley. Those interested can trek to Serolsar Lake instead. The day ends with a bonfire, music, dinner, and an overnight stay at the homestay.

Day 4: Choiee waterfall | Tirthan Valley to Delhi back

Begins with breakfast, followed by a trek to Choiee Waterfall in Tirthan Valley. If time permits, enjoy river rafting in Kullu before departing for Delhi at 7 PM, taking home unforgettable memories.

Day 5: Reach back to Delhi by morning

Reach Delhi in the morning.

Tirthan Valley: A Hidden Himalayan Paradise

Nestled in Himachal Pradesh, **Tirthan Valley** is a serene escape known for its untouched beauty, crystal-clear rivers, dense forests, and charming villages. Located in the **Great Himalayan National Park (GHNP)**, it is an ideal destination for nature lovers, trekkers, and those seeking peace away from the tourist crowds.

Tirthan Valley in Snow

Tirthan Valley Waterfall

One of the must-visit attractions in the valley is the **Choie Waterfall** (also called Chhoie or Chhooi Waterfall). A short trek through dense forests leads to this stunning cascade, offering a refreshing experience amidst nature. The waterfall is particularly beautiful during the monsoon and post-monsoon seasons when the water flow is at its peak.

Tirthan Valley Height

Tirthan Valley sits at an altitude of approximately **1600 meters (5249 feet)** above sea level, providing pleasant weather throughout the year with breathtaking views of the surrounding Himalayan ranges.

Tirthan Valley Temperature

The temperature in Tirthan Valley varies with the seasons:

- **Summer (March to June):** 10°C to 25°C – Pleasant and perfect for outdoor activities.
- **Monsoon (July to September):** 12°C to 20°C – Lush greenery, but occasional landslides.
- **Autumn (September to November):** 5°C to 20°C – Crisp air and vibrant landscapes.



- **Winter (December to February):** -5°C to 10°C – Snowfall and a picturesque winter experience.

How to Reach Tirthan Valley

- **By Air:** The nearest airport is **Bhuntar Airport** (50 km away). From there, taxis and buses are available to reach Tirthan.
- **By Train:** The closest railway station is **Chandigarh Railway Station** (250 km away), followed by a road journey via bus or taxi.
- **By Road:** Tirthan Valley is well-connected via road. **Delhi to Tirthan** is approximately **500 km** (around 12-14 hours by road). Buses to Aut (the nearest bus stop) are available from Delhi, Chandigarh, and Manali, followed by a taxi ride to Tirthan Valley.

Tirthan Valley is an offbeat destination perfect for adventure and relaxation, offering a unique blend of nature, wildlife, and tranquility in the lap of the Himalayas.
